

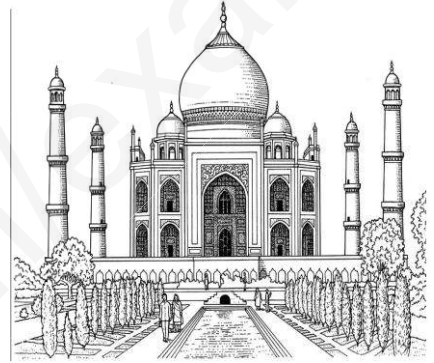

Unfortunately, she died when giving birth to her fourteenth child in 1630. In 1631, Shah Jahan ordered Ustad Ahmad Lahaur to build a sort of temple for her wife in Agra, India that called the "Taj Mahal". It built by more than 20,000 workers and over 1,000 elephants were used to help with the transport of the heavy material during the construction. It took them 22 years to complete the project. Taj Mahal is decorated with jewels, gold and silver. Passages from the Quran are depicted on many walls. The Taj Mahal had four minarets (40 m tall) an huge dome (35m height). It is made of white marble, the colour changes with the time of the day and whether or not there's moon at night.



Taj Mahal became a symbol of endless love and it is an outstanding example of Islamic art and architecture. Some people think it is the most beautiful building on earth. In 1983, the United Nations declared it as a World Heritage Site. The mausoleum attracts more than 8 million visitors every year.

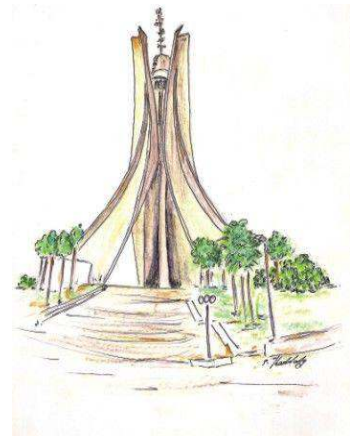

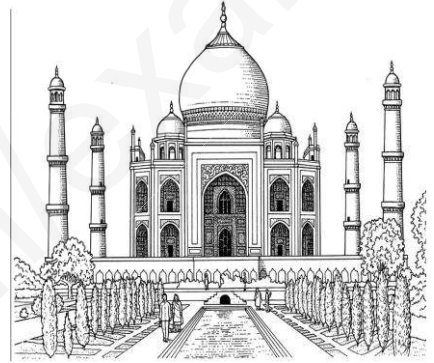
