Cheikh Ben Sliman was born on June 12th, 1908 in Bni Yezguen , Ghardaia. He studied in Annaba then in Tunisia where he learned both Arabic and French. During his stay in Tunisia, he became a friend of Abou El- kacem Chebbi, and he was given the nickname of Moufdi Zakaria by a school friend.

When he returned to Algeria, Moufdi was imprisoned in Serkadji prison by the French for his politics. There he wrote a poem called "Qassaman". It was said that he wrote the poem on walls of his cell using his own blood because he had neither pencils nor papers to write. The poem was later set to music by Mohamed Triki in 1956 and then by Mohamed Fawzi. This poem became the Algerian anthem after the 5th July 1962. when independence was achieved. He also has two famous groups of poetry named "Allahab Al Moqadas" and " Ilyadat Al Djazair".

This outstanding figure was courageous, active and intelligent. All these characteristics and writings made him one of the greatest Algerian poets .Moufdi Zakaria died in 1977 in Tunisia but his body was buried in Algeria.
