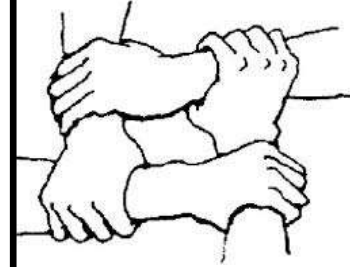
Text
