Text:

Dear lovely students, today on the occasion of the martyr's day 18 February 2023, I am going to tell you about what we have experienced during the French colonization.

I am Djamila Bouhired. I'm a nationalist and militant who opposed French colonial rule in Algeria. I was born in 1935 to a Tunisian mother and an Algerian father and was raised in middle class family. While I was staying at a French school in Algeria, I discovered my revolutionary spirit. When children repeated every morning "France is our mother", I stood up and scream "Algeria is our mother!"

At the age of 20, I started my national activism against the French colonization when the revolution broke in 1954 after 130 years of French occupation. I worked as a liaison officer and personal assistant to FLN commander Yacef Saadi in Algiers, and I was my first to volunteer to plant bombs on roads used by the French military occupation.

In 1957, before a large planned demonstration in the Casbah, I was captured by the French and I was tortured for 17 days where they force me to reveal information about the FLD leader, but I refused.

In July of the same year, I was tried for allegedly bombing a cafe, alongside with another Algerian freedom fighter, Djamila Bouazza, aged 19. That bomb killed 11 civilians inside. I was convicted and sentenced to death by the guillotine. At that moment, many groups formed throughout Algeria and abroad to convince the government to drop the death sentence I served a prison sentence in the Reims prison until 1962. As the end of the war drew near, I was released along with many other Algerian prisoners.
