Donald John Trump is the 45<sup>th</sup> President of the United States, in office since January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017. In addition of being a politician, he is a successful business magnate and television personality as well. He was born on June 14<sup>th</sup>, 1946 in New York City, to a builder and real estate developer Frederick Trump and his wife Mary McLeod. He was one of the five children. He had his initial schooling in the Kew Forest School. At the age of 13, his parents sent him to New York Military Academy, he graduated in 1964. He joined the Wharton School of Finance at the University of Pennsylvania where he graduated in economics in 1968. In 1971, he moved to Studio apartment in Manhattan and became involved with larger building projects. In 1977, he married Ivana Zelnickova and had three children from her.



In 1996, Trump got the ownership of Miss Universe Organization which produces Miss Universe, Miss USA and Miss Teen USA pageants. In 2001, he completed the Trump world tower and began construction on Trump Plaza along the Hudson River. Two years later, he became joint partner with the National Broadcasting Company (NBC) where he became the executive producer and host of the NBC reality show “The Apprentice” which became a huge success. He wrote many books which became famous worldwide for their entrepreneurial guidance. It includes ‘Trump: The Art of the Deal’, ‘Trump: How to Get Rich’ and ‘Trump 101: The Way of Success’. Despite his detractors and all the negative publicity surrounding him, he managed to emerge victorious in the general election on November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016 in which he defeated Hillary Clinton to become the President of the United States.
