Thomas Edison was a very famous business man and inventor. He was born in "Ohio", USA on February 11th, 1847. He started school when he was 8 years old but he didn't do well and ended up, he quitted it shortly afterwards. His teachers thought that he was not very clever. Yet he began to make experiments in Physics at home. At the age of twelve Edison become deaf, but he continued to carry out experiments. On December 9th, 1914 fire destroyed Edison's laboratory while he was making experiments. This didn't discourage him. So he re-built the laboratory and went back to work. When Edison died on October 18th, 1931. He had made more than one thousand inventions.
