Marie curie is commonly known as the mother of modern physics.

She is the first woman scientist and the first woman to be awarded the PHD.

She was also the first woman to win the Nobel prize. Marie Curie was born in Warsaw, Poland in 1867.

Both of her parents were teachers. She began her university studies in Warsaw in 1890. Then, she moved to France where she studied mathematics at the Sorbonne University . She graduated from the university in 1894 .

In 1903 Marie and her husband Pierre Curie , along with another scientist shared the Nobel Prize for chemistry. This worldwide award recognizes the work of scientists, authors and other important people. Marie was the first woman to win this award.

In 1906 Pierre died in an accident on the streets of Paris. Marie was sad, but continued her work. She was awarded again the Nobel Prize for physics in 1911. She created x-ray machines. She was the first person to win two awards in different sciences. Marie died of radiation poisoning on July,1934 in Paris.
