Sara : Good morning Madam. I'm Sara a tourist from France.

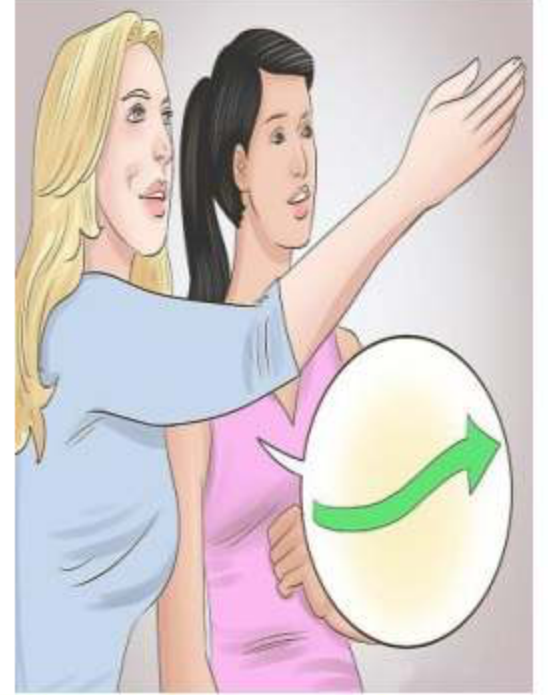
Liz : Good morning Sara. Nice to meet you. How can I help you?

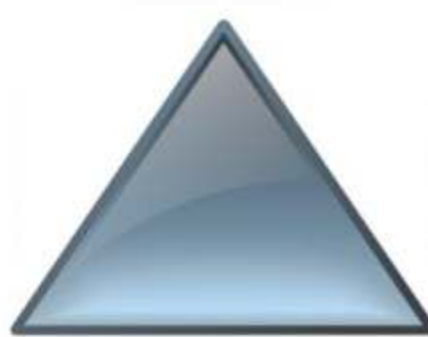
