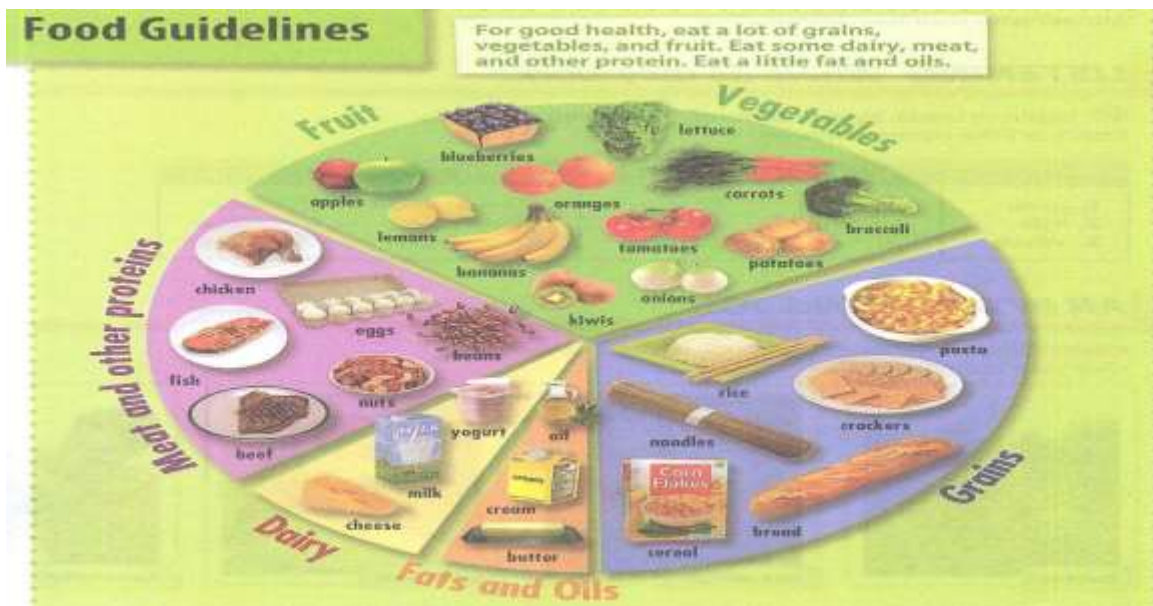


## Me and My Shopping.
