If someone use four or five fingers he's overstepping the bounds of good taste as this is considered to be a sign of over-eating and should be avoided. Menus usually begin with either a soup or salad, followed by roast meat (usually lamb or beef) or fish as a main course, with fresh fruit commonly completing the meal. The national and favorite meal is couscous, or other traditional dishes like "Harira, Thrída, Berkoukes, Chakhchoukha, etc,...
