A report was conducted as part of the *Health Behaviour in School-aged Children (HBSC)* international study to examine teenagers' eating habits. The survey questioned **162,305 teenagers** from different countries. The participants were **boys and girls aged 11, 13, and 15 years old**. They answered an anonymous questionnaire during school time about their daily food consumption.

The teenagers were asked how often they ate healthy and unhealthy foods. When they were asked how often they ate fruit, many teenagers reported that they ate fruit only a few days a week, not every day. When asked about vegetable consumption, the answers showed a similar pattern, as vegetables were not eaten daily by most participants. In addition, when teenagers were asked how often they drank soft drinks or ate sweets, a large number reported consuming these sugary products several times a week.

In conclusion, the report shows that many teenagers do not follow healthy eating habits. Although some teenagers eat fruits and vegetables regularly, the frequent consumption of sweets and soft drinks remains a major problem. The results suggest that teenagers need more awareness and education about healthy nutrition in order to improve their eating habits and protect their health.
