The ancient Mayan civilisation is one of the most fascinating and enigmatic civilisations in history. It flourished in the Mesoamerican region, specifically in present-day Guatemala, Belize, southeastern Mexico, and the western portions of Honduras and El Salvador from the 2000 BCE to 1500 CE.

The ancient Mayans were very religious people. They had many gods and many rituals among them was the brutal practice of human sacrifice performed by the priests to feed the gods and ensure the continued existence of the world. The Mayans were ruled by kings that were considered to be the direct descendants of the Mayan Gods. Mayan society was composed of different classes. At the top were the priests and the nobles. The middle class was made up of the warriors, craftsmen and traders. The farmers, workers and slaves were at the bottom.

The Mayans made significant achievements and contributions in various fields. One of their remarkable achievements was the development of a sophisticated writing system known as hieroglyphics. This system allowed them to record their history, religious beliefs and astronomical observations. Additionally, the Mayans were skilled astronomers and mathematicians. They accurately predicted astronomical events such as eclipses and developed a complex calendar system that is still in use today. Furthermore, the Mayans made great contributions to architecture, constructing impressive pyramids, temples, and cities like Tikal and Chichen Itza. Their architectural designs showcased their advanced knowledge of engineering and their deep connection with the natural world. They also excelled in agriculture, cultivating crops such as maize, beans, and squash using innovative techniques such as terracing and irrigation. Their agricultural practices supported a large population and ensured their survival in challenging environments.

However, by 950 CE, the Mayan Empire would come to a seemingly sudden and unexpected end. Many of the great cities that the Mayans had built were entirely abandoned, and no one knows for certain how it happened or what caused this great calamity. Some archaeologists and historians have suggested that armed conflicts and the exhaustion of agricultural land were responsible for the sudden decline. Discoveries in the 21st century led some others to submit a number of additional reasons such as climate change that caused a severe and prolonged drought which was exacerbated by deforestation and that led to starvation. But what all of them agree about is that the downfall of the Mayan civilisation was not due to one single cause but rather to a complex combination of the factors previously suggested.
