The First Term English Exam ‘Correction’

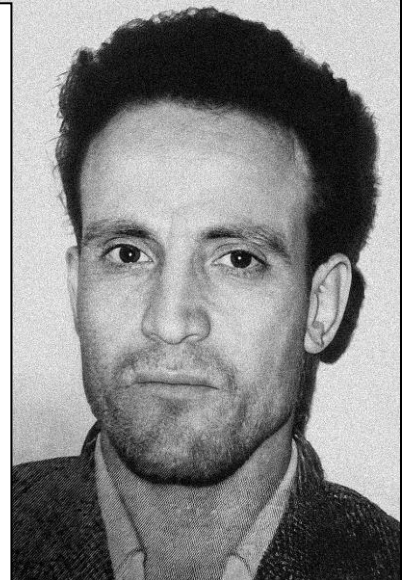
Text :

Mohamed Larbi Ben M'hidi was an outstanding freedom fighter in the Algerian War of Independence. He was born in 1923 in the village of “El Kouahi”, Oum El Bouagui, Eastern Algeria. He joined the Algerian Muslim Scouts in 1939. The tragic events of May 8, 1945, deeply affected him and awakened his desire for Algerian liberation.

In 1954, he played an important role in declaring “the Algerian Revolution”. As he was a skilled organizer and strategist, he successfully led the Soumam Conference in 1956, which was an event that changed the course of the revolution. Sadly, the French Army caught him in 1957 and tortured him, but he never gave up on Algeria's freedom. He was killed on March 4, 1957 in Algiers as a martyr for Algerian freedom.

Ben M'hidi is a symbol of courage and sacrifice. He inspired generations of Algerians to continue the fight for independence, leading to a free Algeria.
