The statue is made of copper. It is very high, about 93 meters from the ground to the top of the torch. Over many years, the copper turned green because of the air and rain. Visitors can climb stairs to the crown. From there, they can see the whole city.

Today, the Statue of Liberty is more than a statue. It is a symbol of freedom, equality, hope, and new beginnings. People from all over the world know it. It inspires visitors to believe in a better future and remember the importance of liberty.

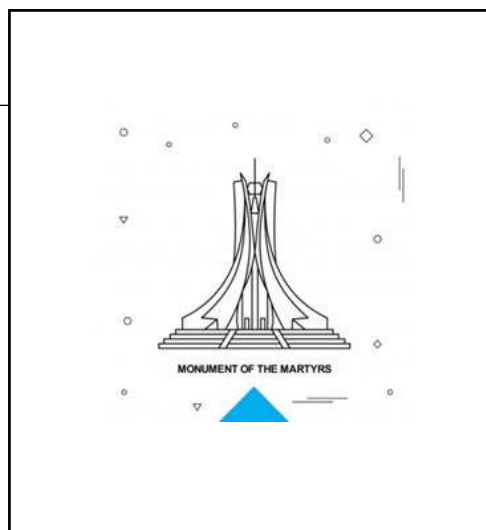
