### The Nobel Peace Prize for 2020

#### Announcement

The need for international solidarity and multilateral cooperation is more conspicuous than ever. The Norwegian Nobel Committee has decided to award the Nobel Peace Prize for 2020 to WFP for its efforts to combat hunger, for its contribution to bettering conditions for peace in conflict-affected areas and for acting as a driving force in efforts to prevent the use of hunger as a weapon of war.

The World Food Programme is the world's largest humanitarian organisation addressing hunger and promoting food security. In 2019, the WFP provided assistance to **100 million** people in 88 countries **who** are victims of acute food insecurity and hunger. In 2015, eradicating hunger was adopted as one of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals.

In 2019, the corona virus pandemic has contributed to a strong upsurge in the number of victims of hunger all over the world. In countries such as the Democratic Republic of Congo, South Sudan and Burkina Faso, the combination of violent conflicts and the pandemic has led to a dramatic rise in the number of people living on the brink of starvation. The WFP has demonstrated an **impressive ability** to intensify its efforts in the face of the pandemic as the organisation itself stated, » Until the day we have a medical vaccine, food is the best vaccine against chaos »

With this year award, the Norwegian Nobel Committee wishes to turn the eyes of the world towards the millions of people who suffer from or face the threat of hunger. The WFP plays a key role in multilateral cooperation on making food security an instrument of peace, and has made a strong contribution towards mobilising UN Member States to combat the use of hunger as a weapon of war and conflict. **Its** work to the benefit of humankind is an endeavour that all the nations of the world should be able to endorse and support
