On the third day

after the earthquake, the village of Swarathok buried its dead. The initial chaos and fear of May 11 had given way to grief and anxiety.

On Saturday, a week after the 7.9 magnitude earthquake that has killed at least 6,900 in Nepal, injured 15,000 and made up to half a million homeless, many of the villagers of Swarathok were waiting. **They** have received almost no aid so far and have not been visited by a single government official. Rashmita Shashtra, a 23-year-old public health student in Swarathok, had told the *Observer*: "No one has come."

The images of Nepal have shown a desperately poor nation, overwhelmed by an immense disaster. This "Great Quake", came at 11.41am on a Saturday. But what **they** have also shown is a government entirely unable to help its citizens. After the funerals on Monday, the 83 householders started organizing. Shashtra dug a notebook out of the rubble and made a list of survivors. She convinced them to pool scant food stocks they had salvaged from their wrecked home, worked out how much each household could have each day. "It is the duty of the government to do this, but when I went to the police they said "just stay where you are". We did not just want to wait and see. So we started acting ourselves. The most important thing is to be united," Shashtra said.
