Whereas women used to wear white clothing until they were married. Both women and men used to wear open sandals which were made from leather.



Jewelry was mostly worn by women. Wealthy women used to wear a wide variety of jewelry including earrings, necklaces, tiaras, and bracelets. Contrary to men whose jewelry included only rings.
