Second term English test

After residents of northern Algerian cities had settled down in front of their televisions on May 21st, 2003 to watch an evening showing of the European soccer cup final, their ceiling and walls began to shake and crumble. The magnitude 6.8 earthquake struck at 19:44 local time, wreaking extensive damage throughout.

Centred in the Boumerdes region some 50km east of the capital city of Algiers, the worst affected urban areas were the cities of Boumerdes, Zemmouri, Thenia, Belouizdad, Rouiba and Reghaia, together with eastern arrears of the capital.

As soon as the earthquake had stopped, hundreds of young people hurried to rescue the injured from under the wreckage of ruined houses and buildings.

According to the reports, deaths totaled 2.226 with further than 10.261 injuries. Structural damage within urban areas was severe, with an estimated 150.000 people displaced from their homes and temporarily re-housed in makeshift tent camps. The May 21st earthquake was the largest to strike Algeria since 1980, when a magnitude 7.3 even caused 3.500 deaths and an estimated 5 billion dollars of damage.
